TANF Ad Hoc Task Force 2015 Report

Congressional activity related to the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) program increased significantly in 2015 -- including several hearings in the House of Representatives, and the release of TANF discussion draft reauthorization legislation by the House Committee on Ways and Means Majority.

As a result, to provide an ongoing space within CCD to monitor TANF-related developments and take action, as needed, Co-Chairs restarted the TANF Ad Hoc Task Force in the fall of 2015.

Meetings will occur on an as-needed basis.
